This is the first of six installments in the Sharing Space series (or a part of the now-combined book, Sharing Space). I really liked Chloe and Patrick, though we don't get as much of his POV as we do of Chloe's in this one. I thought Chloe was super funny and found the book hilarious.

I immediately hung up the phone. "You're a woman. I mean, Pat Murphy is a woman."

The man in my foyer smiled. "Well, I've been called many things, but never that."

Although I marked this book "romance," I only did so because it's eventually going to get into that. So far, there hasn't been anything romantic that's happened, though this installment was only seven chapters, so that's understandable. There were little moments of awareness that the both of them had, with Patrick and Chloe noticing that the other is attractive, but nothing happens between them. I liked that because I prefer the slow-burn over characters jumping into bed with one another. And Chloe and Patrick have only known one another for a couple of weeks.

There is some OM drama, with Chloe having just broken up with her boyfriend, Lawrence. She caught him in bed with another woman and immediately dumped him. However, he doesn't want things to be done, so he calls her throughout the book, including showing up at the apartment once (while Patrick is there) because she's been ignoring said calls. They were together for less than a year (having met just eight months ago), and she wasn't in love with him, though she does admit she was close to it. With Patrick, there hasn't been any mention of OW or of his past yet, but it was only seven chapters, so we'll see if it comes up at a later point.

What I love so far is that Chloe doesn't have a terrible past sex life or sexual hangups, mentioning that things were good between her and Lawrence. She does say that if she bothered to listen to Lawrence's excuses about the cheating, she might feel inclined to look past it and forgive him because she'd want someone there at night because she's lonely. However, she does outright say that it's not Lawrence she wants back specifically, just the companionship.

I'm enjoying it so far and I'm looking forward to the rest!

(And, just for clarity, while the installment is called "Roommate Wanted," it's because her roommate, Grace, is moving out, not because she was living with Lawrence and they've just broken up.)
