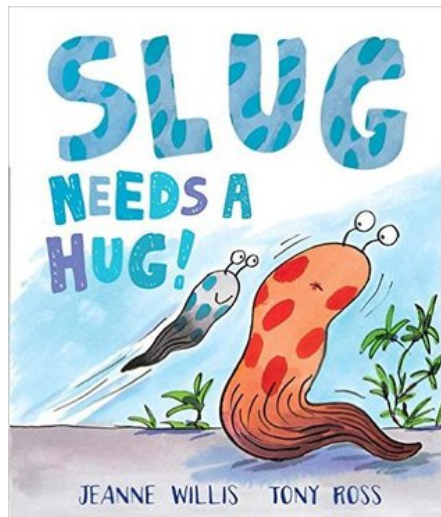




Slug Needs a Hug
