SUMMARY: A class visit to the Gross-Me-Out exhibit at the science museum inspires Stink Moody to create a variety of terrible smells to put in the sneakers he plans to enter in the World's Worst Super-Stinky Sneaker contest.

REVIEW: Another great title in the Stink series (featuring Judy Moody's little brother). Boys should love reading this title with its large font, numerous illustrations, humor, and gross-out topics.

FURTHER FUN: 1) Blindfold and smell objects (not smelly sneakers) and see if the person smelling can identify the object (without looking); 2) talk about talent and ask reader what unusual talent do they have; 3) Talk about unusual jobs; 4) Ask what they want to be when they grow up; 5) Find or design a contest that the reader can participate in as entry and then as judge.
