This is a new author to me, and a new series to me. Although it states this is #1 in the Damaged Hearts series by this author, she has other Shadow Shifters books. I'm guessing that although this is the first of it's series, it is closely related to the others and should not be read first. That is just a guess though.

With that background, I give this one 3 stars. It was okay, but it was super short. Grace and Aidan are college students. They meet when Grace is being hassled at a bar, and Aidan steps in to save her. There are hints that he is drawn to her and later states she is his mate. Having read other shifter novels, I get that concept readily in this work, but he also seems to fight it and state throughout that he is leaving her alone since she is human. That doesn't fit with the one true mate concept. On top of that, we have past trauma to our heroine and completely unbelievable family issues/friend issues, then her current roommate flips out besides, also not believable. It is over the top in all those instances, but we are talking a paranormal romance here. Given my lack of prior knowledge with this author though, I was probably less likely to be invested in this series than others will be who have read others in her series. Perhaps there is more background and attachment to be had to this hero.

From what I got from this short novel, there is going to be a branch of the shifters opening in the east coast of the United States, and our hero will somehow be a part of that branch, finding his calling there fighting rogues (??). I honestly will probably not read more of this series unless I come across older ones and they grab my attention somehow. This snippet did not make me want to continue. It was just short and confusing, and I did not feel any bond or attachment between our hero and heroine. I give it 3 stars as written decently but just "okay" really. Again, my standpoint is that of a brand new reader to this author. Having read other paranormal series, that could in fact impact my rating quite a bit compared to fans of the series.

A whole new sub genre? This is a story about two people who meet at college but to me it's still a romance but I have to admit I'm kind of on the fence about this one.

Aiden is in college determined to finally get his degree. Unfortunately Aiden is at a crossroads in his life as he wants to follow his dreams but as a jaguar shifter his people have expectations for him. Freedom of choice may not be his to take but if that wasn't enough on his plate the woman he meets one night at a bar takes his breath away! Aiden didn't really think it was possible but it looks as if fate just dangled his one perfect mate under his nose and unfortunately she's human!

Grace is the classic poor little rich girl. She's always had everything she wanted except for the one thing she needs, unconditional love. Grace is determined to stand on her own two feet but events from her past still haunt her. Getting involved in a fracas in a bar one night changes everything though as she finds herself face to face with the mysterious and very dangerous Aiden. He is unlike any guy that Grace has ever met but he seems determined to avoid her. The pull between them is magnetic but getting to know more about Aiden will change Grace's life forever.

I have to admit I am a little disappointed with this story. I saw the cover and thought wow that looks interesting and sexy and it really is not that sexy. It's not an erotic story at all and there's very little actual paranormal content in it until nearly at the end. Yes Aiden has an inner beast but I would have liked to read a lot more about it. There is a plot and even bad guys but they just didn't really work for me I'm afraid. It just felt a little rushed at the end. Perhaps the author is aiming at a young teenage audience? Although with that cover I would not have thought so.

I did quite like the characters and the heroine Grace has issues from her past that certainly affect how she feels about men and I thought Ms Arthur covered that very well. It's not easy to trust blindly particularly if you have been hurt and it's something that affects lots of us in some way or another. Aiden is written as a pretty intense young man but I loved his patience and the compassion he shows towards Grace. The most interesting character for me though was Roman who shows up near the end of the book and from checking the author's website I see that he gets his own book which is full length so I just might check that one out. So it's well written and the first of a trilogy about three brothers. It connects with another series from the author but is easily read as a standalone although obviously reading in order would be my choice. It has whetted my appetite for more as I'm curious what will happen next but it probably isn't a keeper for me. If you are someone who has read the other shifter stories from Ms Arthur then perhaps you will already have an invested interest in Aiden which would bring this book even more to life. He's clearly a very passionate and possessive male but it's very short. I just wanted more!

Nooooooooooooo!!!! It can't be the end of the book already. I got sucked into Grace and Aidan's story so fully that the end snuck right up on me and I was NOT ready for it to be over. Mine to Claim is the first novella in the new Damaged Hearts series and it was awesome.

We quickly learn that both Grace and Aidan come from worlds in which their future has been determined by those around them (Grace) or by fate (Aidan). Although they don't immediately reveal all the details of what they each are dealing with (neither to one another or the reader), it is apparent (to all) that they are in similar situations and can empathize with one another, which just seems to increase the intensity of their bond. Although Aiden tries to fight the pull and attempts to convince himself that he should leave Grace alone because he has no future to offer her, his beast (no spoiler on the type of shifter he is) refuses to heed him

and continues to drive him toward Grace – which is fortunate for her as she keeps finding herself in bad situations that Aidan has to rescue her from. Despite the intensity of their reactions toward one another and the obvious chemistry, the author only gives us a couple of heavy make-out scenes. There is more of an emphasis on the emotional aspects of their developing relationship than the physical aspects and Ms. Arthur weaves her tale in such a way that you don't feel short-changed.

Mine to Claim might be just a novella, but it is one that is action-packed and it kept me engaged from beginning to end. When I checked to see if the sequel was out yet I was excited to learn that it is, but then disappointed to learn that it's about Aidan's brother as I wanted more of Aidan and Grace's story. I can only hope that we get an update on them in the next book or perhaps in a fourth book as I would assume that book three will be about the third brother. Either way, I am looking forward to Ms. Arthur's next book in the Damaged Hearts series and hope to check out her Shadow Shifters series as I would love to see what she does with a full-length novel.

I had a number of problems with this book. The first MAJOR problem being that there were a lot of long-bordering on RAMBLING- sentences. I swear more than a few "paragraphs" were really just two extremely long sentences smashed haphazardly together with some random commas.

The inner monologues of the hero and heroine were so dragged out my mind kept wandering to other things. The same could be said for the direction of said monologues. They'd often veer off as if THE AUTHOR'S MIND WAS WANDERING OFF INTO POINTLESS DRIVEL. For example, the heroine would start talking about the outfit her friend picked out for her to wear and- swear to god- by the end of the paragraph she'd be moping about how controlling her parents are and that she's still (figuratively) under their "overly protective thumb".

Like, jfc!! It was these huge jumps in thought, these long sentences, and random facts thrown at us that had me either completely lost or my mind wandering to other things. The author couldn't seem to keep on track. Instead of sentences flowing naturally with a reasonable direction, they'd go from 0 to 100 real quick before the author would almost seem to catch herself and go "shit i have to pace myself".

What I'm trying to say, is the writing was all over the place. It needed direction and instead I got rambling messing all over the place like a puppy that hasn't been potty trained yet and pisses whenever he gets excited.

It pretty much made this story a chore to read. What could have been 40 pages was dragged out into fucking 70 and most of it was the hero and heroine's rambling inner monologues.
