Word choices, flashback sex scenes with individuals other than the two "love interests", something the female main character does that she wouldn't accept from the "love interest", etc. It just seemed that the story was about the sex more than the love story. A sexual journey was how Erotica was described to me and I can see this book falling into that category.

There were several things that just bugged me about the character development and who the characters are. When reading a Romance - regardless of sub-genre - I have a certain expectation when it comes to morals and likability. These characters were not likeable to me.

That being said, when I finished the book on a cliffhanger, I immediately looked to see when I could read book 2. I still want to know what happens. The story was well written, there were only a few inconsistency errors that I noticed (she is going to leave a message and her friend walks in and we never see her leave the message, but she mentions it later that she did - I kept expecting her to realize while speaking with her friend that she just left a message of her talking to her friend).

So, my suggestion... if you do not enjoy reading Erotic Romance or Erotica, do not read this book. If you do enjoy those sub-genres, then give this book a try. It is worth the time.

I am really impressed that Twisted by Desire is a debut novel as the story is quite emotional and confronting as we are dealing with a serious love triangle and as a reader it makes you question your own beliefs as to what you would do in a similar situation.

Fair warning it also has a cliff hanger of epic proportions that leaves you staring at the last page cursing the author for not having book 2 ready to be downloaded. Seriously I would have been pressing the download button and staying up all night to continue on, so kudos there Desiree A. Cox!

Now there are three main characters, Nikki a strong minded career woman and divorced mother who left her husband as in her mind he had no clear direction in life or interest in earning money to make their lives more affluent and secure. Sky is the ex husband and they jointly bring up their daughter in a really great way. Nikki still loves Sky and they have a type of friends with benefits relationship and scratch the itch when needed as on a physical level they simply ignite. Jeff is the new love interest and this is where things get really interesting as he is a real mystery to me. At the start he is easy going and dynamic and Nikki and Jeff have great dates and erotic sex with one condition is that Jeff being older than Nikki has no interest in having his own children - Nikki happy with her daughter agrees to this. Jeff spoils both Nikki and her daughter and the relationship strengthens with a marriage proposal and this is where things get interesting. Jeff once securing Nikki and her daughter in his home starts to change and becomes quite erratic and controlling in his demeanour which only makes me question his character more.

Nikki still loves Sky, Jeff works away doing god knows what (personally I think it is something illegal), Nikki has an itch and sleeps with Sky. Now about now I would be hating Nikki as I hate this scenario but

honestly by this stage in the book I really love Nikki as a woman and mother. I am so torn between Sky and Jeff as they are both giving Nikki the two components you normally get in one relationship - security/stability from Jeff and love/emotion from Sky.

I know that I, personally, have had times when I really did not want to listen to the good advice I was hearing from my besties and family and Nikki goes through the same through the course of the book. A warning up front: there is a cliffhanger ending, which I HATE. But, unlike other cliffhangers, the author has me well-enough invested in the story and in the characters that I actually care about finding out what happens to them in the next two books of the trilogy. Other reviewers come down on the Team Jeff or the Team Sky sides. Given all of the turmoil going on in her life, I'm actually coming down on the side of Team Nikki. This is a girl who really needs to get her life together without the influence of a man so she can know who she is as a person before opening her life up to someone else. A lot of Jeff's behavior screams abuse to me, of the mental and emotional variety, and that really makes me not like him. I feel like there is a lot about Jeff that neither Nikki nor the reader (since this is first person) know about him. And, while Sky was Nikki's first love, some of

what he pulls seems to fall firmly in the emotional blackmail category. So, yeah, Team Nikki, at least for now. I may change my mind after future installments, but I really want to see her stand up for herself and for her daughter. I'm also sort-of wondering if Nikki's friends, or her mother, will stage an intervention at some point.

The sexual situations in this book has it strongly in the Erotica genre. Some of the descriptions the author uses are crude, but overall the book is well-written. I am interested to see how her craft develops over time and see if the characters in the story mature, as well. As stated, with the erotic nature of the book, it's recommended only for readers 18+.
