The relationship between Darrien and Paul is shallow at best and, despite Paul's 'shyness', that sure as crap doesn't stop him from throwing himself at Darrien repeatedly and later, throwing himself at both Darrien and one of Darrien's previous lovers. And yet they're supposed to be uber-possessive forever-mates?

I don't know, I'm just tired of reading novels where super possessive mates or 'exclusive' couples just decide randomly to share as if it were just nothing. Instead of being hot [like a true menage would be] it just kind of makes me view everyone [especially the bottom] as a flagrant whore. /rant.

That aside ... Darrien doesn't tell Paul he's turning him into a dragon which, if the change was more minor, would have been fine. But it's not - it includes fire-[and smoke]breathing, extra horns, dramatic shifts in size and extra appendages. But Paul's okay with it because hell, why wouldn't he be? He just suddenly wakes up one morning with all these changes and - yeah. All cool.

Cons: Maybe it's the genre, or the fact these are ebooks, but I'm noticing a pattern of rushed plot. They are romance novels, I understand, but whenever a plot is introduced, you are making a commitment to the reader. That commitment should be honored. This one left me feeling as if some of the action and drama were haphazardly inserted to bulk up the romance. I also feel that the turning of Paul was dubious, and I dislike dubious in my romance reading. You should never do something to someone irreversible without explaining it entirely and completely to them while they are in their right mind. And the fact that Paul simply accepts it sort of ripped me out of my suspension of disbelief.
