But five years later, Adam is "forced" in vacation by his personal assistants. These assistants who Adam was secretly in lust with, but who were in love with each other and had just gotten married and were going on a honeymoon. So while they were gone, they made sure Adam had somewhere to go, too. They sent him to study languages for three weeks. Turns out, Wren is an instructor there, and neither can resist the pull of the other. Not that Adam tried. Wren was a huge regret in his life, and now that he'd found her again, he wouldn't let her go.

The apartment he was staying in was next door to Tomas. Tomas who is also bisexual and who immediately recognizes the attraction from Adam.
