I'm a long time fan of LLV and pretty auto buy all her books, but this one left me wanting. I liked Kitt and Apple, as well as the premise of the story, but it seemed to just skim the surface for me. For a book told in dual POV; there's a lot of info we don't get. We're told how broken Apple believes himself to be. Additionally, we're told he was a soldier with PTSD, was a cop in LA, that there was a horrible incident with his best friend and he moved to Podunk, Tx because his dad thought it would be good for him to join the Uncertain Saints MC. Now you know all about Apple, oops I forgot, apparently he gets so caught up with quick frantic sex (with Kitt) that he can't remember to use condoms. Oh yeah, about two thirds of the way through we get one sentence where he tells Kitt that he has depression, takes meds, but ran out and that's why he's acting a little off. NOW, you know ALL about Apple. It never really went into depth or expounded how these events helped to shape his life.

Kitt has seizures, but we really don't know why, just that she "zones out" for about thirty seconds when she has one, until she's pregnant, then they go all haywire. There's never any details about how it has affected her life; just that when she gets the bad ones during her pregnancy, Apple holds her for hours while she sleeps. O clube acaba sendo o porto seguro e a família buscada por cada um deles. Um por um vai encontrando a mulher que vai preencher e completar cada um deles. Neste livro temos a história de Core e Kitt.

Core é um veterano de guerra destruído física e emocionalmente, deprimido e com tendências suicidas e que está como prospecto no clube. Nós sabemos que a vida de um prospecto não é fácil, eles passam por todo tipo de provação até serem aceitos como membros efetivos do clube. Um dos membros que antipatiza com Core é Ridley, irmão de nossa heroína. Ridley torna a vida de Core bem difícil no clube.

Core encontrou no clube um propósito para continuar vivendo e acha que não merece mais nada da vida.

Core não se acha merecedor de felicidade porque ele sobreviveu e o amigo dele não.

Kitt tem uma doença em que ela sofre de ataques onde perde a consciência o que deixa Ridley muito preocupado e a vigiando 24 horas. Kitt só quer ter uma vida normal onde as pessoas esqueçam um pouco de sua condição médica e a aceitem como a pessoa vibrante e cheia de vida que ela é. Ela só quer ser normal como qualquer garota da idade dela.

Os dois acabam se envolvendo e Core tenta ficar longe dela achando que não é bom o suficiente. Mas nossa heroína está determinada a encontrar a felicidade e ela quer que Core faça parte da vida dela.

Kitt demorou um pouco para convencer Core que os dois foram feitos um para o outro. Cada um quebrado e problemático, mas que juntos se tornam fortes e mais felizes. I won't go much into details so as not to spoil the reading of you, but the story is great and is worth to be read.

The members of the Uncertain Saint's MC are all bound together by extreme circumstances, each of which is quite problematic and with a sad and heavy story. The Club ends up being the safe haven and the family sought by each of them. One by one will find the woman who will fill out and complete each one of them.

In this book we read the story of Apple "Core" Drew and Kitt.

Core is a veteran of war destroyed physically and emotionally, depressed and suicidal and he is starting as a prospect at the Club. We know that the life of a prospect is not easy, they go through all kinds of trials until they are accepted as full members of the Club. One of the members who dislikes Core is Ridley, brother of our heroine. Ridley makes his life hard at the Club.

Core found in the Club a purpose to continue living and he thinks he doesn't deserve any more of life. Core doesn't think he's deserving of happiness because he survived and his friend did not.

Kitt has a disease where she suffers seizures that she loses consciousness which leaves Ridley very worried and watching her 24 hours. Kitt just wants to have a normal life where people forget about her medical condition and accepting her as vibrant and full of life person that she is. She just wants to be normal like any girl her age.

The two become involved and Core tries to stay away from Kitt thinking he's not good enough for her. But our heroine is determined to find happiness and she wants Core part of her life.

Kitt took a while to convince Core that the two were made for each other. Each one of them broken and problematic, but that both together become stronger and happier. The journey was sometimes hard and sometimes hilarious, but very interesting. I really liked heroin, because despite the disease she didn't let it get to her. She was tireless in pursuit of happiness with Core.

In this book we find out a little more about Ridley and the circumstances in which he lost his wife and also know about another family member. I'm curious about his story.

The story is very well written and we have the participation of other members of the Club, very exciting

scenes, a little mystery and suspense, all very well dosed to hold the reader's attention. The hot scenes between the heroes are perfect.

Bad Apple let us into Apple and Kitt's story, and it's quite a ride...

They are both broken souls, each in his/hers own way, but when they meet something special happens, and they soon realize it, but also fight it. Sure, they give in to their physical attraction, but letting themselves go and trust, is a whole new matter. But they were also aware it was near to impossible mission.

She'd be hell on the heart, that was for sure.

**She may want just a one night stand, but I wasn't one to fool myself.
This, what we had, was explosive.**

Apple is the prospect of the Uncertain Saints, it comes with tasks and rules he's not so kin of, but it's the only thing that gives him some sort of escape from his severe PTSD and an unforgettable and horrific event that happened in his past that doesn't allow him to move on and live a normal life, or look forward for the future, sadly the exact opposite. That is until he meets Kitt. She really brought a new light into his life, the problem is how deeply engrained his trauma and scars have buried themselves in his mind.

**But as I saw the bags under his eyes, I realized then that his wounds weren't superficial. They were deep, and they wanted to hold on and dig deeper.
And he'd been letting them fester.**

Kitt is not with her own brand of problems. The fact that she's the sister of one of Apple's Uncertain Saints brothers, Ridley, may seem like the biggest obstacle for her and Apple's involvement, but it that is only a small part of the problem, on her hand. Kitt suffers from a very particular and dangerous health condition, which she keeps under wraps, as much as she can, but that it that's her brother's overprotectiveness to a whole new level. But she doesn't let that get in the way of her fighting for something she wants, and when she realizes that Apple is her future, she sure as hell is prepared to fight.

Over good food and lots of laughs, I fell deeply in love with Apple Drew.**

And it sure is a rocky road! After their two times together and while Apple is already pushing her away, they find out she is pregnant (which is not the ideal situation in her condition), and that takes their situation a whole new level of problems and misunderstandings, which makes them both suffer immensely.

Misunderstanding after misunderstanding.**

I loved both characters so much! Sure, Apple really made me mad multiple times with his long lasting pushing away, but I understood why, and putting things in his perspective, he really didn't see a way to get out of his own head and dark thoughts. What made me forgive him and swoon was his complete devotion to Kitt, even while apart. I will not reveal too much, but he really was there for her throughout the whole pregnancy and health problems, even if from the distance in most of the times. But I never doubted she was the center of his world, and how much he loved her.

"You smell good," he growled. "And the answer to what's gotten into me, is you. You've gotten into me. I can't stop thinking about you. Your laugh. Your smell. Your taste. Your sense of humor. The way your eyes light up when you experience pleasure. Fucking everything about you has gotten into me, burrowed deep under my skin and won't let me go."

Kitt is an awesome character on her own. Sassy, smart and completely kickass! She doesn't let her health condition restrain her, and that's exactly how she faces life, completely head on! I adored that she fought for what she wanted, and that she never gave up on her biggest fight, for Apple and their love and life together. To bring him to the light! Because she couldn't be more right, she was the only one who could do it. They were, after all, soul mates.

"But not a day has gone by, since I met you, that I haven't thought about you. In fact, it would be safe to say not a single day has gone by where I haven't thought about you several times. I can't even tell you how many times I've wished you were there holding me at night. I'm damn tired, too, of fighting what I feel for you, and I honestly don't want to do it anymore. I'm fucked up. Beyond fucked up."

I love to watch them struggle with their feelings and hatred towards themselves and what they perceive as their shortcomings. Why, you ask? Because when they finally peek through the storm clouds to see the ray of sun shining brightly, they fall that much harder. They make every ounce of pain and every minute of angst worth it because they become a part of a love that is neverending. They begin a journey where you just know the worst is already past them. I feel like they appreciate the little things more and they love deeper. It's simply beautiful to witness, so much so that I sacrificed a night of sleep just to finish what I had started only a few hours prior. There aren't many authors I will forgo sleep for, but LLV is most definitely at the top of the list.

I absolutely loved the brother/sister relationship between Kitt and Ridley in this story. Their playfulness and no holds barred razzing that can only come from siblings who've had a lifetime to learn each others quirks. I loved the fierce protectiveness that both men had for Kitt, even if at times they went about it in all the wrong ways. But I also loved that Kitt never backed down from them. She fought fearlessly for what she wanted, all the while maintaining her endearing snark. I loved how she and Apple clicked from the very beginning, as if they were two lost souls seeking their counterparts. She was just as damaged as he was and in each other they discovered their true selves. The only qualm I have is that we really didn't delve enough into Kitt and Ridley's family, but as Ridley is a member of the Uncertain Saints MC, I know he'll be getting his own story. I'm hoping in his, we will learn more whereas I feel it was just glossed over briefly in this one. I'm a sucker for a good backstory and I just know their family has one. Especially after the glimpses we received here.

Beyond the love story, I love the humor that LLV injects into even the tensest of situations. Wait until you read the last few chapters. I can promise you that you will never see it coming and I find myself wishing it was more detailed than it was. Needless to say, I was CRACKING up... I loved all the issues that this story touched that I felt hadn't been approached in any of her other books. There was a rawness to Apple's

emotions that can be incredibly hard to portray, but LLV did it in such an honest fashion that it brought tears to my eyes multiple times. Bad Apple is the fourth addition to Lani Lynn Vale's Uncertain Saints MC series. This series is a bit darker and grittier than fans are used to seeing from Vale, but she's done a great job tackling the sensitive and difficult topics in this book while staying true to her unique writing style. Always well written, always full of surprises, steam and laughter, a Lani Lynn Vale novel is something I always look forward to.

Vale took on some hard subjects in this book, and she did them well. Apple "Core" Drew is a good guy battling some serious demons. He's heavy with nearly crushing guilt, and he has a hard time accepting the love, happiness and pleasure that Kit brings to his life. He struggles with it and pushes her away before he finally reaches out for the help that he needs. It's never easy for these badasses to admit a weakness, but Core does it. This type of situation isn't always pretty, and it can be downright brutal sometimes, but Lani seemed to find just the right balance in telling this story and portraying these characters realistically and genuinely while still delivering everything that her fans have come to love about her writing, her characters and their stories.

Kit is the sister of Ridley, an Uncertain police officer and a member of the Uncertain Saints MC. Having no other family but each other and the Saints members, the two of them are very close. Kit has a medical condition, and Ridley's taken steps to make sure that she'll always have help if she needs it. She meets Core, and she's smitten right away. Ridley isn't necessarily on board with a Kit and Core pairing, though, so Core's got some work to do there to sway his brother. With Kit, if it's not one thing, then it's another. Despite their best laid plans, though, neither Core nor Ridley could have been prepared for what lay ahead for Kit.

I really love this series, it's so different from anything Vale's done previously. I like that she's taking on these tough subjects, and I think she's doing a great job with them. In Bad Apple, she managed to soften the hard edges of Core's story with her trademark sense of humor. Let's be honest here, no Vale novel would be complete with it or those funny, quirky little quotes that kick off each chapter. Fans of Vale's, like me, greatly anticipate that banter and the antics of her heroes and heroines, along with the steamy build-up of her romances, and it's here in spades.

I love this series, I loved Core and Kit, and I can't wait for more Uncertain Saints. Lani Lynn Vale's Bad Apple get 5 smooches from me.
