Without wishing to include spoilers here, I will say only that The Travelers is a modern take on witches and wicca, even though the story can be said to stretch way back into the distant past. Indeed, the characters in the story practice time travel of a sort, in a unique kind of way.

The witches in the book are modern (or appear to be) yet they use ancient spells in the here and now in order to achieve their goals. The references to Wicca and to its spells are very well researched and knowledgeable.

Two things in particular resonated with me whilst reading this book. The first, that there is a point at which it is said that certain characters behave as they do due to the teachings of an ancient, almost 'holy' book - which has very obvious real world parallels. The second, the love story that develops between two characters from families that are sworn, historical enemies (within the context of the story) reminded me a little bit of Romeo and Juliet, though the outcome... well like I said, no spoilers here!

This is a well written story that takes a uniquely different view of witchcraft and rivalry. It has love and romance, adventure and good old fashioned Good v. Evil. An enjoyable read!

Dagny has plenty of skills, but she has no idea that she's extremely powerful. What she does notice is that she doesn't have to chant spells to get things done. She can just think about something and it will happen. Dagny doesn't want her family to know this, which is why she chants anyway. Dagny feels like an empty shell. Traveling from body to body is incredibly hard on her. She hasn't mastered to keep her memories yet, so every time they travel Dagny loses part of it. She just wants to be a normal teenager and wants to stop

running. When she meets Marc on a plane Dagny finally has the chance to live a little. Dagny is impulsive and reckless, but is also sweet and innocent. She intrigued me because she is still a child in a lot of ways, but can act responsible when she needs to. I hoped Marc would be the one who could make her stop running, they have an interesting connection that fascinated me from the moment they met.
