This was a great love story! Oz and Sean meet at the wedding of Oz's brother and Sean's sister, and are pushed together as they are the only gay people at the wedding. Turns out they hit it off, even though neither feel they are worthy of the other. Sean heads back to NYC while Oz stays in Austin, neither able to forget their time together. More weddings take place, and they invite each other as wedding 'guests' and their bond deepens. There were a couple of typos, but aside from that, this was a great read, and the internal dialogues that helped keep Sean and Oz from confessing how they really feel actually make sense!

Seth says

The characters are sweet and intriguing, and the plot has a lot of potential, but in the end this story is very VERY painfully repetitive. There were pages where more or less the same thing would be restated, slightly rephrased, in three places. The internal concerns keeping the characters apart are also frustrating, as even slightly more open communication could have gone a long way, if not all the way, towards resolving them quicker. This feels like an excellent short story turned into a long novella by rambling and adding filler paragraphs, which pains me to say as I have enjoyed other stories by this author.

Egregious example, from an intimate scene: "This was just like the first time, when he couldn't move, could barely breathe, but Oz was so hot that he didn't care. He'd wanted him since the moment they'd parted ways, and now he was fully getting him. It was so good, so perfect. he'd wanted Oz since the moment he saw him and he hadn't stopped wanting him since. Not even when they'd been apart."
